The diversity in military interests of the council was demonstrated at the onset as charter members included D.R. Bob Robinson, Daniel Higgins, Bill Scott, Butch Crandall, John Raffetto, Al Broyer, George Duff, Alvin Carveth, Harry Rosenberry, Bill Cassidy, William Moore, Paul Claiborne, Sr., Leland Propp and W. E Jansen.
